1. Welcome

a. Meeting recording available on YouTube.

2. Updates

- a. The deprecation of Google Map services and database replication issues impacted the CEDEN Advanced Query Tool (AQT) over the last several months. However, it seems to be stable now; any potential issues should be sent to ceden@waterboards.ca.gov.
- b. Note that there is a backlog of data to be uploaded through the State Board (which is the pathway submitted to when using the data checker at ceden.org), which we hope to resolve over the next couple of months.

3. CEDEN Modernization – Dissolved Fraction

a. This item is a follow-up to previous User Group discussions. After considering the history of the dissolved fraction definition (see supporting CEDEN Constituent Update memo from 2012) and the repercussions of changing it with the move to CEDEN 2.0, the benefits do not appear to out-weigh the costs of making this change. Therefore, we do not plan to change the definition, it will remain "Material that passes through a filter no larger than 1.0 um or as defined by the analysis method." Tessa Fojut, the Surface Water Ambient Monitoring Program's Quality Assurance Officer, joined the meeting to discuss.

4. CEDEN Modernization – Quality Assurance Project Plans

a. We continue to work on the CEDEN Modernization effort, which is a proof of concept project to customize EQUIS data system. It includes an online widget, allowing data providers to view and request vocabulary and check and submit chemistry results online. The data checking incorporates formatting checks, as our current system does, as well as completeness and quality checks. The system will utilize an electronic Quality Assurance Project Plan (eQAPP). More information about this feature is in the attached.
