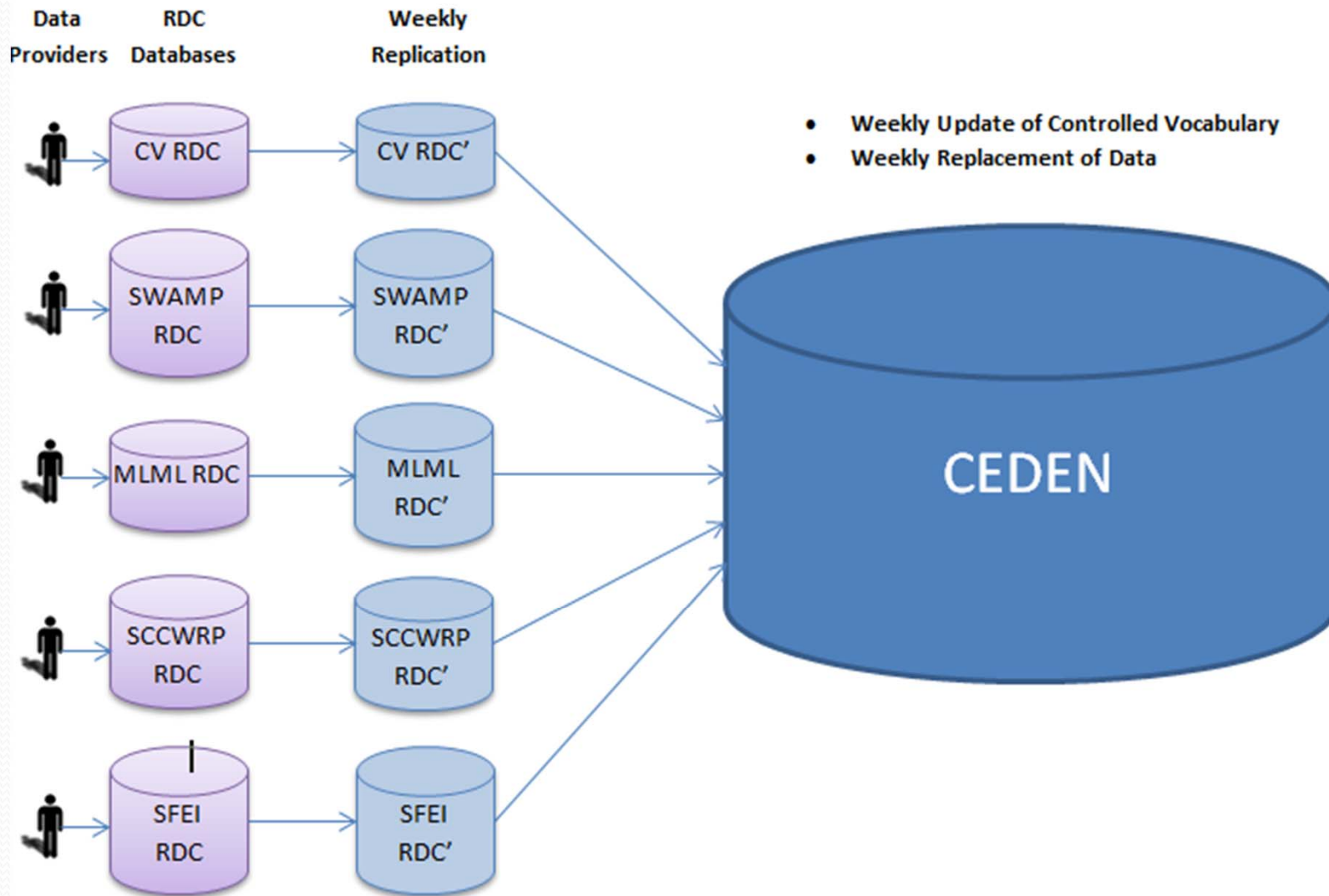
Background



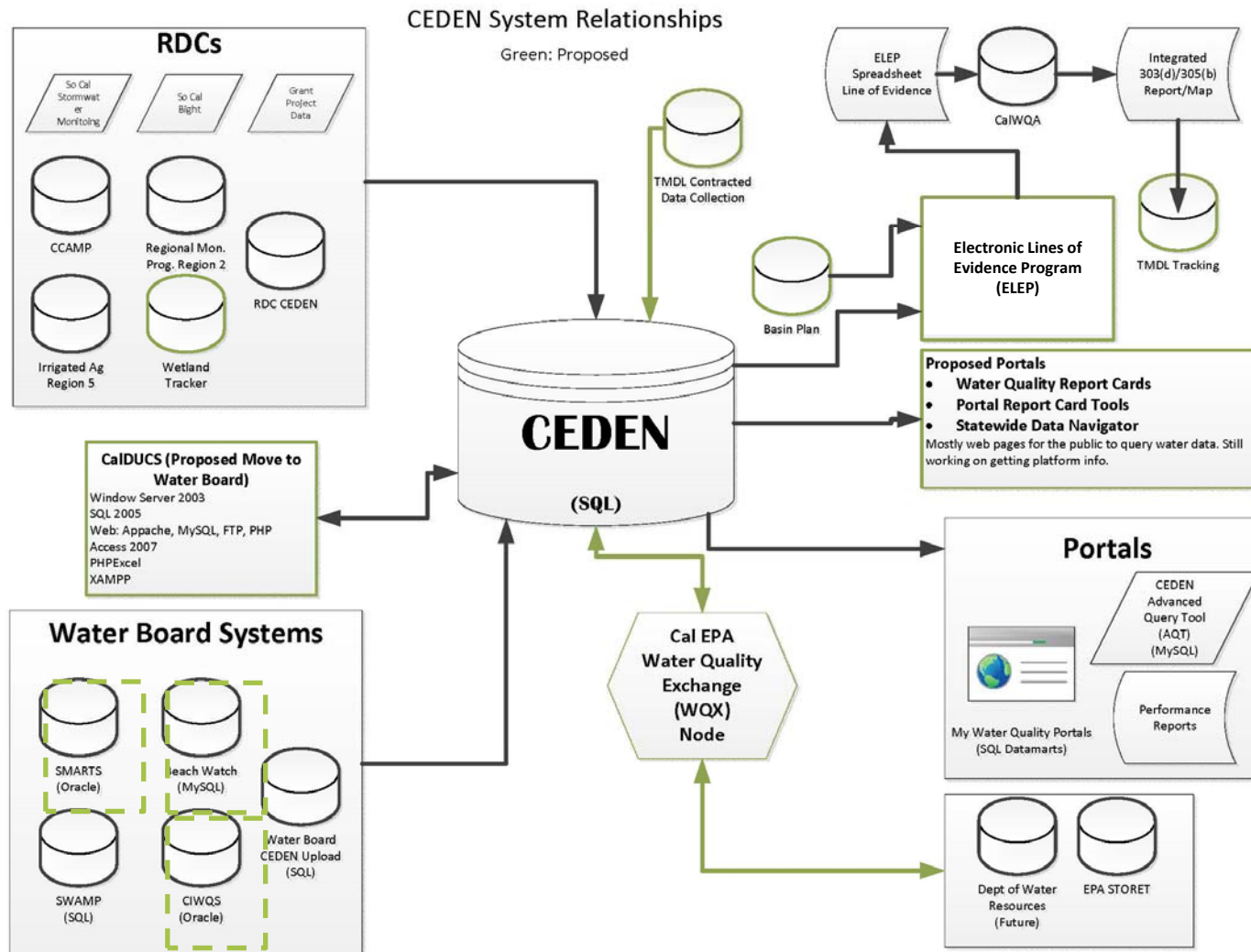
CEDEN

CEDEN is a central location to find and share information about California's water bodies, including streams, lakes, rivers, and the coastal ocean. Many groups in California monitor water quality, aquatic habitat, and wildlife health to ensure good stewardship of our ecological resources. CEDEN aggregates this data and makes it accessible to environmental managers and the public.

Recent History

- Aug. 2013 – Established “new” templates
- Dec. 2013 – New WB CEDEN staff
- June 2014 – Change to database backend to use SWAMP 2.5 structure and move it to be housed at the Water Boards
- Dec. 2014 – Resume refresh of query tool
- Feb. 2015 – Adoption of Impaired Water Bodies Listing Policy Amendments to include that “readily available data” are data that are in CEDEN
- March 2015 – Open communication with Stakeholders



Current Projects

- EPA Grant to Connect to WQX and Create Webservices
- Connect to CIWQS/SMARTS
- Loader at State Board



Long Term

- Implement solution to address identified needs that cannot be addressed in the near term
